ROCK CHALK OPEN HIGH SCHOOL MEET | JANUARY 28, 2024 | ANSCHUTZ SPORTS PAVILION | LAWRENCE, KAN.

The Anschutz Sports Pavilion/Bill Easton Track & Field Facility is a 6 lane 200m oval with 8 lane straightaway providing athletes and coaches a better track & field experience while competing at the University of Kansas. The track oval, horizontal and vertical jump surfaces have been resurfaced with the Benyon BSS 2000 with a Hobart topping. Parallel horizontal runways are located on the east side, and the pole vault runways are on the south end. High jump and throws will be contested on the infield. All coaches must stay in the designated coaching boxes or general spectator areas to ensure safety to athletes and coaches.

ONLINE ENTRIES

This meet is open to the following (no exceptions): High School athletes, grades 9-12 (high school identification required). Entries will open on Monday, January 8, 2024 at 9:00 am (CST) must be completed through Direct Athletics at <u>directathletics.com</u> by 10:00 pm (CST) on Tuesday, January 23, 2024. Entry fees must be paid through Direct Athletics, \$20.00 per event. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

EVENT CHECK IN

Track athletes must check in at the athlete check in table next to the meet headquarters table 30 minutes prior to their event. We will re-seed events if necessary to ensure full heats. Once heats have been re-seeded, late check in athletes will be placed in slower heats.

Field events will have their own head official. Field event athletes will need to check in with the head official of their event, at the event area, 45 minutes prior to the start of their event.

Weigh in for the shot put is two (2) hours before the competition at the competition site.

BIB AND HIP NUMBERS PICKUP

Bibs and hip numbers pick up will be on meet day, Sunday, January 28, at the meet headquarters area, near the starting line on the west side of the track starting one (1) hour prior to the competition beginning.

WARM-UP AREAS

No warm-ups will be permitted on the track at any time.

RESULTS

Unofficial results will be posted after each event on the west wall of Anschutz Pavilion. Complete/final results will be available after the meet at www.blacksguirreltiming.com and KUAthletics.com.

RULES

1. NFHS rules will be in effect unless otherwise noted. This is not a NFHS sanctioned event; you may not compete in high school uniform or under your high school's name. Only 1/4 inch spikes will be allowed on track facility, shoes will be inspected. Boys will throw the 12lb shot and girls will use the 4k shot. Athletes will throw from a 40 degree sector. Pole vault weight verification forms are required for all pole vaulters.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event. Awards can be picked up at the meet information table near the finish line on the west side of the track.

PARKING

Spectator Parking:

Spectators must park in the parking garage north of Allen Fieldhouse at Naismith Drive & Irving Hill Road, with one entrance on Irving Hill Road.

An hourly charge for parking in the garages is \$1.75 for the first hour, and \$1.50 per each additional hour, or any portion thereof. Non-payment will result in issuance of fines.
